### **New Programming Efforts**

HVADC is pleased to announce our FeedHV program is now active in Sullivan County. FeedHV is a regional food rescue and gleaning network dedicated to meeting the needs of neighbors while mitigating the impacts of food waste. The concept evolved out of community dialogues with farmers, volunteers, nonprofit agencies and key stakeholders. Through our web-based and mobile application powered by ChowMatch, FeedHV links food donors of prepared but unserved food and fresh produce (including farms, restaurants, catering services, grocery stores, hospitals, universities and more) to nonprofit organizations with food assistance programs (such as food pantries, soup kitchens and shelters) through the efforts of a network of volunteers who transport, glean and process donated food. Outreach in Sullivan County began in 2020 and the network now includes two farm donors, four recipient agencies, one volunteer for the County. Outreach efforts have been hindered by the Covid crisis; however, our staff is continuing to develop relationships to further assist the efforts of the feeding agencies in the County.

**WHEREAS**, HVADC's mission is to enhance the agricultural sector in the Hudson Valley by assisting both new and existing agri-businesses, and supporting policies and regulations that recognize and support New York State's agricultural economy; and

**WHEREAS**, HVADC's programs are designed to support growth and development of agriculture and related industries by providing agribusiness technical assistance, project planning and development services, agricultural development support and capital access planning; and

WHEREAS, SCFC recognizes the importance of farming and related agricultural businesses on the County's economy; and

**WHEREAS**, SCFC has determined that HVADC's corporate purpose is closely aligned with SCFC's mission of encouraging economic development in Sullivan County, including farms and related agricultural businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, SCFC wishes to provide financial support to HVADC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by SCFC as follows:

- Section 1. SCFC is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Agribusiness Agreement with HVADC for the period commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2023.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Chairman or Chief Executive Officer of SCFC, each acting individually, are each hereby authorized, on behalf of SCFC, to execute and deliver the Agribusiness Agreement.
  - Section 3. The officers, employees and agents of SCFC are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of SCFC to do all acts and things required and to execute and deliver all such certificates, instruments, documents, and to pay all such fees, charges and expenses and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or in the opinion of the officer, employee or agent acting on behalf of SCFC desirable and proper to effect the purposes of the foregoing resolutions and to cause compliance by SCFC with all the terms, covenants and provisions of the documents for and on behalf of SCFC.
  - Section 4. These resolutions shall take effect immediately.

# AgriBusiness Agreement

THIS AGRIBUSINESS AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), is effective as of July 1, 2020 by and between Sullivan County Funding Corporation, a non-profit local development corporation duly organized, existing and in good standing under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal office located at 548 Broadway, Monticello, New York 12701 ("SCFC") and Hudson Valley AgriBusiness Development Corporation, a New York not-for-profit corporation, with its principal offices located at 507 Warren Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Hudson, New York 12534 ("HVADC").

### Recitals

**WHEREAS**, HVADC's mission is to enhance the agricultural sector in the Hudson Valley by assisting both new and existing agri-businesses, and supporting policies and regulations that recognize and support New York State's agricultural economy; and

**WHEREAS**, HVACD's programs are designed to support growth and development of agriculture and related industries by providing agribusiness technical assistance, project planning and development services, agricultural development support and capital access planning; and

**WHEREAS**, SCFC recognizes the importance of farming and related agricultural businesses on the County's economy; and

**WHEREAS**, SCFC has determined that HVADC's corporate purpose is closely aligned with SCFC's mission of encouraging economic development in Sullivan County, including farms and related agricultural businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, SCFC wishes to provide financial support to HVADC.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the covenants herein contained and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is mutually agreed as follows:

# 1. Funding Commitment.

SCFC agrees to provide funding to HVADC in the aggregate amount of \$75,000.00, to be paid in three (3) equal annual installments of \$25,000.00 each covering fiscal periods commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2023. Funding commitments, other than the \$25,000.00 installment covering the period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021, are subject to annual approval by SCFC.

### 2. Services – In General.

HVADC shall use the SCFC funding primarily for its stated purpose of fostering the growth and development of agricultural businesses and opportunities in Sullivan County and the Hudson Valley region.

# 3. Reporting.

HVADC shall provide SCFC with a comprehensive annual report of its Sullivan County activities and regional activities impacting Sullivan County at times to be arranged between HVADC and SCFC.

### 4. Insurance.

Effective as of the date hereof and until SCFC consents in writing to a termination, HVADC shall maintain or cause to be maintained insurance against such risks and for such amounts as are customarily insured against by not-for-profit entities of like size and type paying, as the same become due and payable, all premiums in respect thereto, including, but not necessarily limited to:

- A. Insurance against loss or losses from liabilities imposed by law or assumed in any written contract and arising from personal injury and death or damage to the property of others caused by any accident or occurrence, with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident or occurrence on account of personal injury, including death resulting therefrom, and \$1,000,000 per accident or occurrence on account of damage to the property of others, excluding liability imposed upon HVADC by any applicable Worker's Compensation Law.
- B. Worker's compensation insurance, disability benefits insurance, and each other form of insurance which HVADC is required by law to provide, covering loss resulting from injury, sickness, disability or death of employees of the HVADC.

All insurance shall be procured and maintained in financially sound and generally recognized responsible insurance companies selected by HVADC (and reasonably satisfactory to SCFC) and authorized to write such insurance in the State of New York. Such insurance may be written with deductible amounts not exceeding \$2,500.00. All policies evidencing such insurance shall provide for at least thirty (30) days written notice of the cancellation thereof to SCFC.

All such certificates of insurance of the insurers that such insurance is in force and effect, shall be provided to SCFC effective on or before the commencement of the term of this Agreement. Prior to expiration of the policy evidenced by said certificates, HVADC shall furnish SCFC evidence that the policy has been renewed or replaced or is no longer required by this Agreement.

### 5. Hold Harmless.

HVADC shall indemnify and hold harmless SCFC and its directors, officers, employees, members, agents, representatives (except HVADC), their respective successors and assigns and personal representatives harmless from and against any and all liability for loss or damage to property or injury to or death of any and all persons that may be occasioned by any cause whatsoever pertaining to this Agreement, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, reasonable attorneys' fees and any other expense, incurred in defending any suits or actions which may arise as a result of any of the foregoing.

### 6. General Provisions.

A. <u>Notices</u>. All notices required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and may be delivered by hand, by overnight courier of national reputation, or by United States mail. Notices delivered by mail shall be deemed given three Business Days after being deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, registered or certified mail. Notices delivered by overnight courier of national reputation shall be deemed given the next day after mailing providing evidence of receipt and properly addressed. Notices delivered by hand shall be deemed given on the day of delivery. All notices shall be addressed as follows:

- B. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the internal laws of the State of New York.
- C. <u>Construction</u>. All defined terms used herein shall be applicable equally to the singular and plural forms of such terms. This Agreement executed and delivered in connection with the Agreement shall be interpreted without regard to any canons of construction which require that a document be interpreted or construed against the party which caused the same to be drafted.
- D. <u>Severability</u>. Whenever possible, each provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted in Agreement shall be prohibited by or invalid under applicable law such provision shall be ineffective only to the extent of such prohibition or invalidity without invalidating the remainder of such provision or the remaining provisions of this Agreement.
- E. <u>Headings.</u> All section headings herein have been inserted for convenience of reference only and shall not affect any construction or interpretation of this Agreement.
- F. <u>Assignment and Assigns</u>. HVADC shall neither assign nor delegate any of its duties arising under this Agreement without the prior written consent of SCFC.

G. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.
